Yes, it's true! We are officially re-opening the Club and we need your help. (See Grand Opening ad, page 3).


That means every member, both men and women. The Kitchen area equipment and and appliances have been professionallv cleaned. Now we need to get the rest of the building up to standards.

Some of you may not know that the Hernando Beach Yacht Club (HBYC) is a proud member of the Yachting Club of America (YCA), National Association of Yacht Clubs. The YCA was founded in 1963 as the first National Association of Yacht Clubs.

YCA membership includes Yacht and Sailing Clubs throughout America with a membership of over 700 YCA-registered Yacht and Sailing Clubs. As a member of YCA, we enjoy "reciprocity" with all other YCA Yacht Clubs. We have a book at the Club, updated annually, listing all YCA Clubs. This book is available for all members to view.

Reciprocity is defined as "the state of being reciprocal; mutual dependence, co-operation, exchange of courtesies, or return in kind, etc. The policy under which special advantages are granted by one side in consideration

of same by the other."

This means that as HBYC members, we can go to other yacht clubs all around the country! Many of you have taken advantage of this member benefit but others may not have even known this opportunity existed.

Each Yacht Club has different requirements related to reciprocity and it is best to call ahead and find out what they are before going to another yacht club. Some clubs require a "Letter of Introduction" signed by the Commodore, while others only require that you have your HBYC/YCA membership card,

We have a letter of introduction on file in case you ever need one. If you are planning a trip and would like to visit another Yacht Club, I would be happy to help you to determine if the Yacht Club is a member of YCA and, if they
