#### Three Years As Commodore

The pandemic forced us to make

some major modifications to our plans. The entire Board was involved in every decision we made throughout the pandemic and has continued to remain vigilant to ensure the safety of Club members.

#### **Income Limited**

Because of the Club's closure, from March 2020 through April 2021, the Club's income was severely limited and, beginning June 1, 2020, we were operating with a minimum of an \$800 monthly shortfall (minimum assuming no addition-

al unexpected expenses).

## Special Assessment

To cover this short-fall, the Board proposed to levy a \$100 **Special Assessment** to all Club members, payable to the HBYC by July 15<sup>th</sup>. This one-time assessment allowed

us to cover our expenses in 2020 and was split equally among all members. I would like to thank all members for generously paying this assessment that basically "saved the Club" during the
