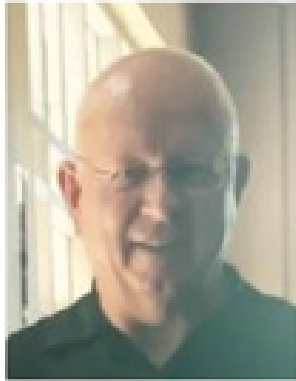

BEWARE OF DICK!!!!

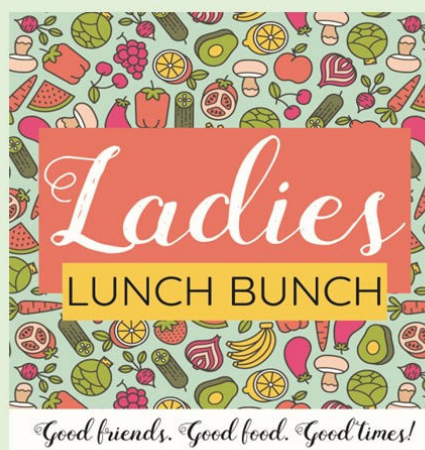
