Member Profile

Lidia Verdon

Lidia was born in Barcelona, Spain, and grew up amidst the brutal aftermath of the Spanish Civil War. As a young woman seeking opportunity,

she emigrated from Spain to America on a four-year scholarship to New York University.



NYU

At NYU she

majored in European languages and American History. As a student, she worked a variety of jobs to support herself and quickly learned English. (She is also fluent in Spanish, Catalan,

Spanish Civil War

The Spanish Civil War, (1936-1939), has been called the "dress rehearsal" for WWII. The war pitted the Spanish Fascists under General Francisco Franco against the Spanish Communists.

An estimated 500,000 people died as the result of combat, systematic killings, mob violence, torture, and other brutalities.

Franco's Fascists, who were supported militarily by Nazi Germany and Mussolini's Italy, won the war and carried out mass reprisals afterward. Historians estimate that Francoists executed at least 150,000 Spanish citizens during and after the war.

In that period Lidia Verdon grew up in Barcelona.

Marriage

While still in school she met the man who would become her husband. They were married and had three children, all boys.

At this time Lidia worked as a translator for a medical trade journal and also worked as a guide at the Smithsonian Institute in New York City.

Tragedy

A few years later, Lidia's life changed drastically when her husband passed away and she was left with three little boys to raise by herself.

She needed a job that paid more and when she heard about a health and exercise company that was coming to New York, Gloria Marshall Figure **Salons**, she applied and was hired.

In just a few months she was a store manager and, a year later, a supervisor of five stores at five different locations.

Love

At this time, she met the love of her life and remarried. The man was a wonderful husband and father to her children, Lidia says, and by then, with family life settled, it was time to pursue other interests.

Lidia went back to school and earned certifications in **Gemology** and **Diamontology**, then took a job in New York City's diamond district in mid-town Manhattan.

Diamontology/Gemology

Diamontology is a branch of gemology that deals specifically with diamonds, typically for the purpose of increasing a diamond buyer's knowledge of a diamond under consideration for purchase.

Gemology is the scientific study of gemstones. In ancient times, and even today, gemstones have been considered universal talismans of wealth and power.


